Eye	intense, deep purple red
Nose	very complex wine. It presents a great nose, full of small red berries, and opens to hints of graphite and spice, ending with a final gentian
Mouth	on the palate, it is deep and takes all the space. It has great structure and complexity. A bit of overripe gives a good sweetness, the final is mineral and fresh
