LES DEUX PETITS COEURS ROSÉ

VARIETAL: Merlot 100%

PARCEL: Champagnole, in the town of Villeneuve

PLANTING YEAR: 1999

ALTITUDE: 710 m asl

SOIL: White sandy marl

DENSITY: 10,000 vines/ha

VINE TRAINING: Spurred cordon

YIELD PER HECTARE: 80 q

VINIFICATION: Pressing of whole grapes, static decantation, fermentation in stainless steel

AGING: For 6 months in stainless steel

ALCOHOL CONTENT: 13%

TASTING NOTES: Onion pink in color, the nose gives off concentrated sensations of red berries (currants and cranberries), laced by delicate floral and balsamic hints. In the mouth, the powerful sip is accompanied by a pleasant and enveloping mineral vein. The wine is a perfect balance between body and freshness, revealing the juiciness of Merlot, the finesse from the sands and the acidity endowed by the elevated mountain slopes.
