VARIETAL: Pinot Gris 100%

PARCELS: 3, in the town of Villeneuve

PLANTING YEAR: 1993

ALTITUDE: 750 - 800 m asl

SOIL: Sandy moraine

DENSITY: 9,000 - 10,000 vines / ha

VINE TRAINING: Spurred cordon

YIELD PER HECTARE: 8 t

VINIFICATION: White vinification

AGING: In stainless steel, with bâtonnage

ALCOHOL CONTENT: 13.5%

TASTING NOTES:

Light and bright straw yellow color. Nose with strong floral scents (almond) accompanied by mineral nuances.

Full and mature palate, characterized by notes of white flowers, a very subtle tannic vein typical of Pinot Gris and a sapid and fresh stretch.
